



Webinar Certification and Trademark License Requirements

Music Keys

Requirements for Webinar Training Certification

Complete the 6 hour *Music Keys* Webinar. Cost \$275, includes teacher materials.

- Be present for and participate in each of the sessions.
- Watch videos as assigned before or between the webinar sessions.
- Show the ability to sing tunefully in the proper register and to keep a steady beat. This will be demonstrated within the context of the webinar, as participants will be assigned simple songs and patterns to sing and chant during the webinar. Anyone not able to show these abilities at that time will be assigned follow-up times to work with a teacher-trainer to work to attain these goals.
- Complete assignments given by trainer. Most assignments are due within 2 weeks of completion date of the webinar.

Upon completion of the above, you will have completed your Music Keys certification requirements.

Music Keys License

There are multiple ways to become certified to use the *Music Keys* License:

- 1) Complete the Music Keys 6-hour webinar, or
- 2) Complete a *Cycle of Seasons* 17-hour summer training session, or
- 3) Complete a *Cycle of Seasons* 12-hour webinar series.
 - Anyone who is certified in Cycle of Seasons or Music Keys is eligible to apply for a Music Keys license.
 - The Music Keys license requires the signature of the director of each particular school where Music Keys will be offered.

The annual cost of the Music Keys license is \$75.00. **(License price is subject to change. Call 800-216-6864 for current License cost)**

NOTE: If you currently hold a Musikgarten License, a separate Music Keys License is not required. All other requirements for purchasing and using the Music Keys materials will still apply. Teacher must have training in Cycle of Seasons or Music Keys and supply Musikgarten with a signature from the participating school administrator/director/owner approving the program.
